| Spelling (SP) | Letter Writing requires the examinee to write lowercase and <br> uppercase letters. Word Writing requires the examinee to <br> correctly spell words of increasing difficulty. |
| Written Composition <br> (WC) | Requires the examinee to spontaneously write; evaluates <br> theme, organization, voice, word choice, sentence fluency, <br> presentation, and conventions. |
