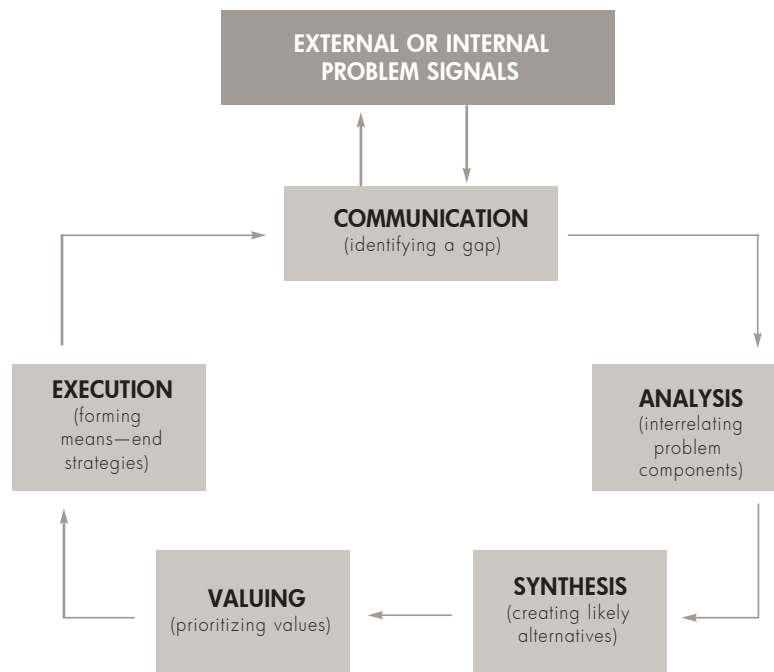
Pinpoint the nature of career problems

- Measures negative thoughts in career choice.
- Identifies the specific nature of negative thinking.
- Includes three construct scales: Decision-Making Confusion, Commitment Anxiety, and External Conflict.
