## A fast, efficient report to complement the PAS or PAI

The PAS-O is the ONLY measure of psychopathology normed on informant and self-report discrepancies.

- When used with the PAS, the PAS-O allows you to gain valuable insight from someone close to the client to help screen for clinical issues and determine the need for follow-up testing.
- If PAS or PAS-O results indicate the need for in-depth testing, the PAI provides information relevant for clinical diagnosis and treatment planning.
- Consists of 22 items that are directly parallel to the 22 items on the self-report PAS and corresponding items on the parent instrument, the PAI.
- Suitable for instances when a client is unable to complete the PAS due to confusion, thought disorder, or other limitations.
- The only informant report compatible with the PAS and the gold-standard PAI.
- Requires just two forms—a Response Form and a Score Summary and Profile Form.
- Can be completed in just 5 minutes.

## The PAS-O adds an observer's perspective to a client's PAS results; both tests are based on the PAI.
