| Atypical (ATY) | Behaviors frequently associated with psychotic disorders (e.g., bizarre <br> beliefs, hallucinations, delusions, self-harm, excessive fears) |
| Irritability (IRR) | Persistent and chronic irritability that permeates most aspects of the <br> child's life (e.g., emotional dysregulation, behavioral/emotional <br> outbursts, demandingness) |
| Grandiosity (GRAND) | Elevated sense of self and mood (e.g., not taking responsibility for <br> actions, exaggerating, stealing) |
| Hyperactivity/Impulsivity <br> (HYPER) | Classic description of overactivity and impulsivity (e.g., difficulty sitting <br> still, acts without thinking about consequences, always on the go) |
| Aggression (AGG) | Aggression targeting other people, animals, and/or objects |
| Inattention (INATT) | Traditional scale for inattention and distractibility (e.g., difficulty <br> focusing, difficulty sustaining attention) |
| Affect (AFF) | Mood changes (e.g., mood disturbances, suicidal ideation, cognitive <br> distortions) |
| Social Interactions (SOC) | Ability to interact with peers (e.g., ability to make friends, relate to <br> others, engage in social interactions) |
