The SPECTRA is a brief, self-administered, multiscale measure of psychopathology and functioning based on the quantitative (three-factor) model of psychopathology.

- The SPECTRA stands out as a low burden (96 items), psychometrically sound tool that not only maps on to DSM-5® conditions but also links assessment findings to the expanding quantitative model research literature.
- The SPECTRA is the only instrument based exclusively on psychopathological (quantitative
- The SPECTRA is unique among existing assessment instruments in that it measures psychopathology at three levels of specificity.
- These are divided into three sets of four scales each that compose the three spectra: Internalizing, Externalizing, and Reality-Impairing.

- The three spectra combine to form a general factor called the General Psychopathology Index (GPI), which provides a measure of total psychopathology burden.
- The SPECTRA measures psychopathology at three levels, allowing clinicians to gather information on a wide range of psychiatric conditions.
- The SPECTRA is versatile. It can serve as a primary or supplemental measure across a broad range of clinical and research settings.
