Some IDEA criteria may be missed or not included with other measures.



An **interpretive framework is provided** to identify students who meet the IDEA criteria for an emotional disturbance.

Lacks scales/subscales and puts the user in the position of having to make many "interpretive leaps" when assessing eligibility.



Detailed strength information including a Resilience Scale and Motivation Cluster.

Less focus on measuring a child's strengths and how this could impact treatment.



Includes a broad two-factor **social maladjustment scale**.

May not include social maladjustment scale.



By including the student's perspective, **the self-report improves:**

- Usefulness
- Accuracy
- Interventions

May not be available as a report option.

A self-report is not included in the multirater report or may not be part of the test at all.
